

LAGI 2020 Fly Ranch Photo Reference

To assist your design process and to provide a background for visualization of your proposal in the landscape, you will find hundreds of photos of Fly Ranch available to download. The photos are limited to the primary site boundary areas (shown in yellow).

Over 1,400 photos were taken on June 11, 2019 as ice pack melt continued to flow across the site into the Hualapai Flat. You can see the walking path of the photographer in the map to the left.

At certain vantage points along the path corresponding to the camera icons on the KML Google Map (https://tinyurl.com/LAGI2020), 360 degrees of photos were taken along with one lower resolution (iPhone) panorama.

The high resolution versions that have been stitched together have a naming convention such as "IMG_3787-IMG_3796.jpg" to show what original photos were used to stitch the high-res panorama (not all originals have been stitched together, but most have).

You'll also find some random wildlife shots and some short movie clips here and there. You'll see the seasonal creek that was crossed, a lizard, lots of horses, and some startled deer.

The 3D Land Mapping downloads provide some additional 360 panoramas shot from a drone.
